Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How many Unitarian Universalists are there?

A: Around 800,000 people around the world consider themselves to be Unitarian Universalists.

Q: What's the Dress Code?

A: Our motto of "come as you are" extends to our dress code, so we promote a casual atmosphere. You're welcome here, no matter what you wear.

Q: What does a typical service look like?

A: Generally, our services run an hour. We offer a medley of experiences and affirming service activities, which include excellent music from our choirs, readings from inspiring figures, passionate talks from our beloved minister, and "Candles of Community," where one can briefly share a joy or a concern.

Q: How do I become part of this community?

A: We have many ways to get involved in the Fellowship. To start, check out one of our services -- the friendly volunteers at the Welcome Table in the foyer can help you pick up some informational pamphlets about Unitarian Universalism. If you want to join as a full-time member, keep an eye out for "Path to Membership," which happens 2-4 times a year, depending on interest. There, you can learn more in depth about the Fellowship, the Unitarian Universalist faith, and more.
