#### WHAT IS A WORSHIP ASSOCIATE?

A Worship Associate is a member of our congregation who wants to work with Rev. Lydia for at least a year in a group of individuals to build worship that reaches our hearts, challenges our minds, and lifts our spirits.

### WHO SHOULD APPLY?

We are looking for a diverse group to continue this exciting, fulfilling program with Rev. Lydia.

We need the Worship Associates to represent our Fellowship with a **balance of gender, age, sexual orientation,** and cultural/religious diversity. What is your religious background? Buddhist? Jewish? Christian? Humanist? Or all the shades of in-between that are sometimes held by Unitarian Universalists?

### WHAT IS THE TIME COMMITMENT?

Be on board with 2 Worship Associates trainings a year - the first training is Saturday, April 30, from 9am-4pm. Serve as a Worship Associate with Rev. Lydia, a guest minister, or with your colleagues to design and deliver meaningful worship 3-4 times a year. Participate in group theological reflection with Rev. Lydia about upcoming themes about four times per year (on the month before one is serving as a WA). These meetings will be at 6 pm on the first Wednesday of the month, prior to the Worship Services Committee meeting. Attend the subsequent Worship Services Committee meeting (first Wed., 7pm) to provide reflection on the service you led.
